

BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR COPPER TREE RETREAT SCHOOL OF MASSAGE

Capable of completing courses

Free of conviction, plea of nolo contendere, or deferred adjudication for any prostitution, other sexual offense or violent crime.

Admission Requirements: •Toured the School •Completed the Copper Tree Retreat School of Massage Application •Have a Valid Photo Identification •Have a Social Security Number (Valid Proof includes a social security card, W-2, or tax return) •Must be physically, mentally, emotionally, and financially capable of completing the course work •Must be at least 17 years of age at start of program •Must be free of criminal convictions (A student is ineligible for licensing if he/she been convicted of, entered a plea of nolo contendere or guilt to, or received deferred adjudication for an offense under Chapter 20A, Penal Code, or Subchapter A, Chapter 43, Penal Code or another sexual offense, or convicted of violation of Chapter 455 Occupations Code Massage Therapy Act is ineligible for a license as a massage therapist until the fifth anniversary of the date of conviction) If you are concerned that your criminal history may preclude you from becoming licensed, you may submit a \$25 fee and the Criminal History Evaluation Form to TDLR.
